

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the April 15, 2011, Progress Report submitted by Maxis Engineering, Inc. According to the report free-phase product has not been detected since August 2009; including monthly gauging events conducted from March 2010 through March 2011.

EPD approves of the request for No Further Action for the petroleum release at referenced above. However, further corrective action may be required, if mandated through more stringent state or federal statutory or regulatory changes. Additional measures may also be required if existing or future drinking water systems or surface water bodies within two miles of the site are impacted by any dissolved contamination resulting from this site, or if previously unidentified soil contamination, dissolved contamination or free product are identified as originating at the site.
